The Nylons' – Claude Morrison, Gavin Hope, Garth Mosbaugh and Tyrone Gabriel – forthcoming album will be a collection of jazz pop standards delivered in the band's unique a cappella style featuring their dazzling arrangements and soul shifting harmonies.
